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Was geschah in den letzten Jahren des Paulus? Ging er noch nach Spanien? Wie und warum starb er? Waren seine Pläne in Erfüllung gegangen oder enttäuscht worden? Wie können wir die spärlichen Quellen deuten? Und wie lassen sich diese Fragen aus den sozialen, historischen und rechtlichen Kontexten im Leben des Paulus erhellen? Zur neuen Erörterung dieser zentralen Fragen hat eine Gruppe international ausgewiesener Wissenschaftler ihre Kenntnisse und Perspektiven zu den römischen, jüdischen und frühchristlichen Kontexten in denen Paulus lebte und starb, zusammengetragen. In einer neuen Diskussion der wesentlichen Quellen werden neue Fragen und Hypothesen entwickelt, die für alle relevant sind, die mehr über die letzten und traumatischen Jahre des Paulus wissen wollen.

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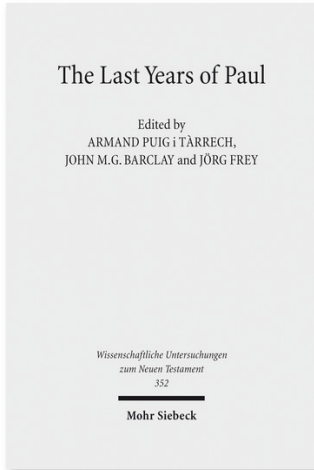
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
