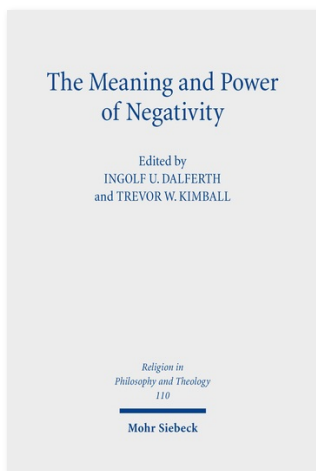


The Meaning and Power of Negativity
