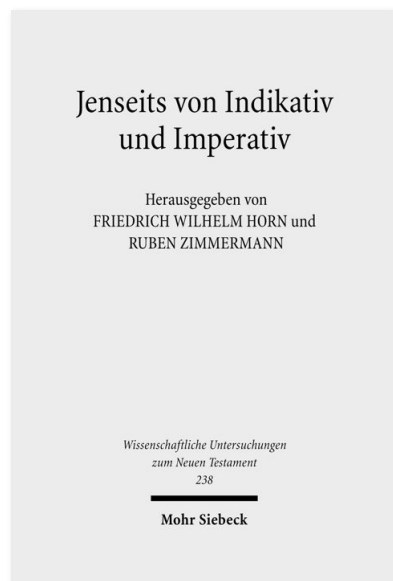


Jenseits von Indikativ und Imperativ

The widely-used division of ethics in New Testament writings into the categories »indicative and imperative« does not withstand a critical examination of the text. Hence the authors of this volume attempt to go beyond the indicative and imperative to describe and explain these ethics. They reveal that the New Testament texts put forth very different justifications for the right conduct or the good in New Testament texts and that a complex methodological approach is necessary in order to illustrate these arguments and their backgrounds.
