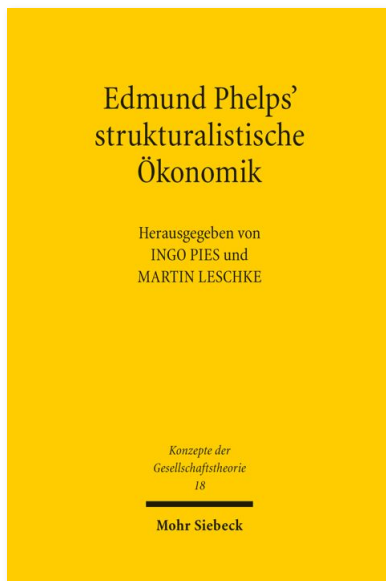


Edmund Phelps' strukturalistische Ökonomik
