**Bernhard Zimmermann** ist Ordinarius für Klassische Philologie an der Albert-Ludwigs-Universität Freiburg im Breisgau.

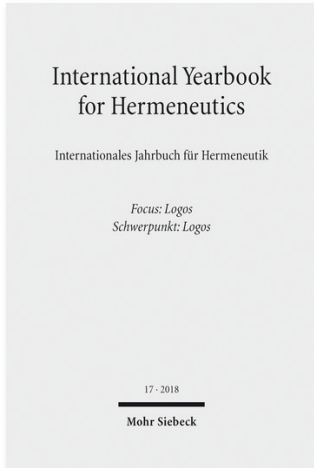
