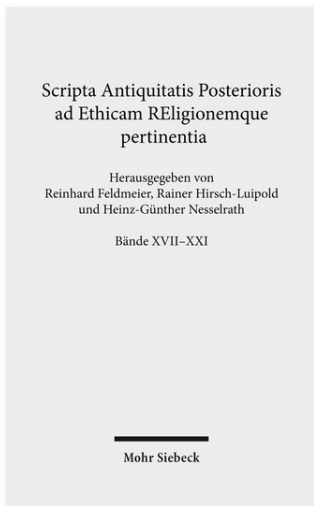
It is the goal of the SAPERE series (Scripta Antiquitatis Posterioris ad Ethicam RELigionemque pertinentia, Writings in Late Antiquity on Ethical and Religious Issues) to make Greek and Latin texts from late antiquity (1st to 4th century AD) available in an innovative combination of edition, translation and interdisciplinary commentary in an essay form. A careful scholarly examination of the texts which are explained from various angles in the essays is combined with a linguistic presentation which does not lose sight of the relevance of the texts for the history of ideas and at the same time shows the importance of authors of antiquity for discussions on current issues.

Rainer Hirsch-Luipold Born 1967; studies in Protestant Theology and Greek Philology; since 2011 Professor of New Testament and History of Ancient Religion, University of Bern; since 2015 also Extraordinary Professor in the Department of Ancient Studies, Stellenbosch University.
