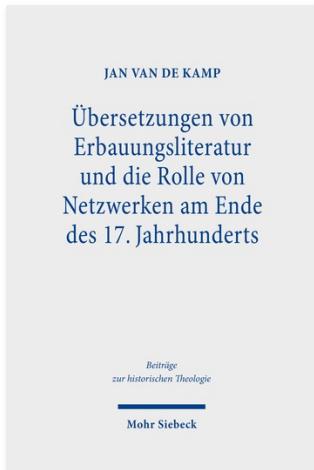
[The Translation of Devotional Literature and the Role of Networks at the End of the Seventeenth Century.]

The author also addresses the influence of other piety movements on German Pietism as well as the links between them.

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
